Dutch Oven Cook-Off Official Rules & Guidelines

Event Overview:

The Dutch Oven Cook-Off is a fun and friendly culinary competition designed to showcase creativity and skill in Dutch oven cooking. Entries must fall into one of the following **two** categories.

Categories:

- Main Course
- Dessert

Competition Divisions:

Den/Patrol Division:

Cooking is completed by a group of youth participants in a den or patrol. Adult leaders may advise but may not participate in the actual cooking process.

• 18+ Division:

Cooking is completed by a single or duo individual, age 18 or older.

General Rules & Requirements:

Supplies & Equipment:

Participants are responsible for bringing all necessary food items, cooking supplies, and equipment. Charcoal will not be provided and must be off the ground.

Signage Requirements:

Each entry must include a clearly visible sign (maximum size: 8.5" x 11") that:

- Displays the name of the dish.
- Lists any ingredients that may trigger common allergies (e.g., peanuts, shellfish, dairy).

• Cooking Guidelines:

- All dishes must be prepared exclusively using Dutch ovens.
- All a majority of food must be cooked on-site.
- The use of electrical outlets or electric kitchen appliances is NOT permitted.
- Participants must provide their own method of keeping perishable ingredients properly chilled.

Site Conduct:

- Cooking stations will be assigned by the event coordinator
- Only those actively involved in food preparation may be in the cooking area.
- All participants are expected to practice good sportsmanship and conduct themselves in a respectful manner.

Food Safety & Sanitation:

- o Proper hygiene and food safety practices must be observed at all times.
- Hands, surfaces, and utensils should be kept clean throughout food preparation.
- Use disposable utensils for tasting and adjusting seasonings.
- Participants must clean up their cooking area upon completion.

Event Schedule:

- 9:00 AM Cooking area opens; setup may begin (no early access permitted)
- 1:00 PM Main Course tasting and judging begins
- 3:00 PM Dessert tasting and judging begins
- 7:00 PM Awards presentation at campfire

Awards & Judging:

Awards will be presented to the top three entries in each division and category, as
determined by a panel of three judges.

Final Notes:

While this is a judged competition, the primary goal is to have fun, share great food, and learn new techniques. We look forward to seeing your creativity in action!
