The Glenn A. and Melinda W. Adams National Eagle Scout Service Project of the Year Award recognizes Eagle Scout projects that demonstrate exceptional leadership, planning, and lasting benefit to the community. This year,

Eagle Scout Paris De Guzman was recognized for a conservation project at Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument that removes invasive species, protects restricted areas, and installs a boot brush station to help prevent the spread of invasive seeds. Her efforts help preserve the monument's unique ecosystem and protect one of the region's most important Ice Age fossil sites for future generations.
